Full Closure of Northbound State Route 73 Connector to Southbound State Route 55 Week of August 7, 2017

Santa Ana – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has begun a construction project to upgrade safety devices along 16+ miles of State Route 55 from SR-1 in Costa Mesa to the SR-55/SR-91 Separation in Anaheim. During the week of August 7, 2017 construction crews will close the North SR-73 connector to the South SR-55. The connector closure will occur nightly from 11p.m. to 5 a.m. for K-rail installation. Detours will be posted to alert motorists.

Caltrans appreciates the public's patience during this necessary upgrade of the freeway system.
