## LITTER REMOVAL WITH WORK ALTERNATIVE PROGRAM PERSONNEL AND CALTRANS FORCES—BEGINS MONDAY IN MONTEREY COUNTY

MONTEREY COUNTY—a week-long litter removal project will begin on various highways in Monterey County, starting Monday, Feb. 1, Caltrans officials have announced.

Locations are as follows:

- Hwy. 1 from Rio Rd. to the junction of Hwy. 156 in Carmel;
- Hwy. 156 to the junction of Hwy. 183 in Castroville;
- Hwy. 68 from the junction of Hwy. 1 to the junction of Hwy. 218 in Del Rey Oaks.

Litter removal will take place along the shoulders and medians, therefore, no lane closures will be required. Roadwork is expected to be completed by Sunday, Feb. 7, weather permitting.

This roadwork is being performed by Work Alternative Program personnel and the Salinas North and Monterey maintenance crews.
