U.S. HIGHWAY 101 LITTER REMOVAL PROJECT ALONG CENTER MEDIAN BETWEEN SOLEDAD AND SALINAS FOR THREE DAYS NEXT WEEK

MONTEREY COUNTY – A three-day litter removal project will take place in both directions along the center median of a 25-mile segment of U.S. Highway 101 between the Salinas River Bridge in Soledad and Airport Boulevard in Salinas, starting Tuesday, October 14 Caltrans officials have announced.

Work hours are from 8:30 am to 3 pm each day. Minimal delays are anticipated. Work should be completed on Thursday, Oct. 16.

Message signs will be posted to advise motorists about this litter removal project.

This roadwork is being performed by various Caltrans maintenance crews from Salinas.

Caltrans reminds motorists to move over and slow down when driving through highway work zones.
