NORTHBOUND U.S. HIGHWAY 101 LANE CLOSURES BETWEEN SAN MIGUEL CANYON ROAD AND MESSICK ROAD NORTH BEGINS MONDAY

MONTEREY COUNTY – Caltrans will close the #2 (right) lane for less than ½-mile of northbound US Highway 101 between San Miguel Canyon Road and Messick Road North for up to three days starting Monday, Sept. 19 from 9 am until 2 pm to perform drainage repairs.

Electronic Message Boards will be activated to alert motorists of these alternating lane closures. Delays should not exceed 15 minutes.

This roadwork is part of the winter storm prep efforts and is being performed by Salinas North maintenance crew. Work is scheduled to complete by Wednesday, Sept. 21.

Caltrans reminds motorists to move over and slow down when driving through highway work zones.
