SWEEPING OPERATION ALONG U.S. HIGHWAY 101 BETWEEN SALINAS AND PRUNEDALE—BEGINS MONDAY, JUNE 27

MONTEREY COUNTY – A three-day, sweeping maintenance operation requiring a moving lane closure along **both directions** of a 13-mile section of U.S. Highway 101 between Airport Boulevard in Salinas and San Juan Road in Prunedale will begin Monday, June 27, Caltrans officials have announced.

Roadwork is scheduled from 9 am to 2 pm each day from Monday until Wednesday and consists of a lane closure of the #1 (left) lane.

NOTE: There will be an Electronic Message Board alerting motorists, who can expect delays between 10-15 minutes. The CHP will be present to assist with traffic control.

The purpose of this project is to provide motorists and bicyclists a safer route to travel and better rideability. Roadwork is scheduled to be complete by Wednesday, June 29.

This roadwork is being performed by Salinas North maintenance crew.

Caltrans reminds motorists to move over and slow down when driving through highway work zones.
