LANE CLOSURES ON HIGHWAY 183 IN SALINAS AND HIGHWAY 218 IN DEL REY OAKS AND SEASIDE FOR PAVING—STARTING NEXT WEDNESDAY, JUNE 1

MONTEREY COUNTY – A slurry seal paving project to re-surface a two-mile section of Highway 183 from the Highway 183/101 separation to just west of Market Circle Street in Salinas, and a two-mile section of Highway 218 (Del Rey Oaks Blvd.) from the Highway 1/218 interchange to Highway 68 will begin next Wednesday, June 1, Caltrans officials have announced.

The project will include one-lane reversing traffic control and lane closures between 9 am and 4 pm, Monday through Thursday. The Hwy. 101/183 and Hwy. 1/218 ramps are subject to closure between 9 am and 4 pm. No roadwork will take place on Fridays or weekends. Motorists can expect delays of up to 15 minutes.

Electronic message signs will be posted alerting motorists of this paving work, which is necessary for the preservation of the road and safety of travelers.

The contractor for this \$717,000 project is Telfer Pavement Technologies of McClellan, CA. It is scheduled to be complete by the end of August.

Caltrans reminds motorists to move over slow down when driving through highway work zones.
