ONE DAY TREE TRIMMING ON SOUTHBOUND HIGHWAY 1 NEAR CARMEL MONDAY

MONTEREY COUNTY – As part of the Hwy. 68 Roundabout project, a one-day, tree trimming operation on a ½-mile section of southbound Highway 1 between the Hwy. 1/68 connector and San Luis Avenue (North) near Carmel is taking place Monday, Oct.10.

Roadwork consists of closing the #2 (right) lane from 10 am to 2 pm. Motorists can expect delays of 10-15 minutes.

The purpose of this tree trimming operation is to improve traveler safety by removing a hazardous pine tree adjacent to the freeway.

The contractor for this operation is Granite Construction of Watsonville. The CHP will assist with traffic control.

Caltrans reminds motorists to move over and slow down when driving through highway work zones.
