OVERNIGHT CULVERT REPLACEMENT ON HIGHWAY 68 NEAR LAGUNA SECA ENTRANCE—STARTS MONDAY

SALINAS –Crews will be working on an overnight construction project to replace a failing culvert near the entrance to Laguna Seca on Highway 68 (Holman Hwy.) in Salinas starting Monday, Feb. 8, Caltrans officials have announced.

Overnight roadwork will consist of a lane closure with flagging, Monday through Thursday from 8 pm to 5 am (Friday morning). No weekend roadwork is scheduled. Electronic message boards will be posted to alert motorists, who can expect delays not to exceed 15 minutes.

It is necessary to replace the existing culvert since it is failing, roadwork is scheduled to be complete by Monday, Feb. 29, weather permitting.

The contractor for this \$100,000 project is Granite Construction Co. of Watsonville, CA.

Caltrans reminds motorists to move over and slow down when driving through highway work zones.
