CALTRANS ADA PROJECT IN SANTA CRUZ AND MONTEREY COUNTIES CONTINUES

SANTA CRUZ AND MONTEREY COUNTIES – The American with Disabilities Act (ADA) project in Santa Cruz County (Highways 1 and 9) and Monterey County (Highways 68 and 218) which began last November continues with ramp and electrical work, Caltrans officials have announced.

Roadwork hours are from 7 am until 3 pm. Most of the electrical work has been completed.

Roadwork next week will include work on Hwy. 68 at Pasadera Dr. and on Hwy. 218 at Pheasant Ridge Rd. and Carlton Dr.

The electrical work at Hwy. 68 and York Road, was completed on Thursday, Jan. 14.

This roadwork is part of a project to construct curb ramps, sidewalks, modify signal and lighting that is compliant with the American with Disabilities Act (ADA).

The contractor for this \$1.1 million project is Pacific Infrastructure Construction, LLC of Vacaville, CA. This project is expected to be completed by the end of April, weather permitting.

Caltrans reminds motorists to move over and slow down when driving through highway work zones.
