MOBILE SCAN SURVEY OF U.S. HIGHWAY 101 IN CARPINTERIA AND MONTECITO THIS WEEKEND

SANTA BARBARA COUNTY– A mobile scan survey of US Highway 101 in the Carpinteria/Montecito area will take place on Saturday, Aug. 22 and Sunday, Aug. 23 from 7 am until 9 am.

On Saturday, Aug 22 there will be a rolling 30 mph closure of **northbound** US Highway 101 from Bailard Avenue to North Padaro Lane and **southbound** from the truck parking area north of Evans Avenue to South of Linden Avenue.

On Sunday, Aug. 23 there will be a rolling 30 mph closure of **northbound** US Highway 101 from North Padaro Lane to Cabrillo Boulevard and southbound from Milpas Street to North Padaro Lane.

Motorists should be advised that the on/off ramps within the survey area will be closed for a few minutes each day while the survey team makes two passes over this route.

The California Highway Patrol (CHP) and the Caltrans Santa Barbara Maintenance group will assist with traffic control. This Mobile Terrestrial Laser Scanning (MTLS) vehicle allows for survey work to be conducted minimizing exposure to highway workers which maximizes safety.

Caltrans reminds motorists to move over and slow down when driving through highway construction zones.
