NORTHBOUND HIGHWAY 17 FOUR-DAY OVERNIGHT LANE CLOSURE BEGINS MONDAY

SANTA CRUZ COUNTY– An overnight permit project for four nights under permit to place a new strand and fiber for Comcast Cable on northbound Highway 17 between Glenwood Drive and Spanish Oaks Road near Scotts Valley begins Monday night, May 4, Caltrans officials have announced.

- Roadwork consists of closing the #2 (right) lane of northbound Hwy. 17 between Glenwood Drive and Spanish Oaks Road for four nights between 9 pm and 5 am the next morning
- Motorists can expect minimal delays as the #1 (left) lane will remain open at all times.
- Work is expected to be completed by 5 am on Friday, May 8.

The contractor for this permit project is Cable Com LLC, of Castroville, CA.

Caltrans reminds motorists to move over or slow down when driving through highway work zones.
