The National Highway System (NHS) is divided into the following subcategories: Non-Interstate STRAHNET, Major STRAHNET Connector, Intermodal Connector, MAP-21 Principal Arterial, and Other NHS Routes. Strategic Highway Network (STRAHNET) routes are important to U.S. strategic defense. Intermodal connectors provide access between major intermodal facilities. The MAP-21 Principal Arterials subcategory was expanded in 2012 with the approval of federal reauthorization bill MAP-21. Other NHS routes capture the remaining routes within the NHS.
