## **CALTRANS ANNOUNCES STATE ROUTE 99 DETOURS IN MADERA COUNTY**

**WHAT:** INTERMITTENT DETOURS OF NORTHBOUND AND SOUTHBOUND STATE ROUTE (SR) 99 TRAFFIC WITHIN THE CITY OF MADERA FOR DRAINAGE AND ASPHALT OPERATIONS ON STATE ROUTE 99.

**WHEN:** TUESDAY, JULY 6<sup>TH</sup> –THURSDAY, JULY 8<sup>TH</sup> FROM 9:00 P.M. UNTIL 5:00 A.M. EACH MORNING.

**WHERE:** WITHIN THE CITY OF MADERA, SOUTHBOUND/NORTHBOUND SR99 AT THE STATE ROUTE 145 INTERCHANGE.

Due to a bridge widening project currently in construction, drainage and asphalt operations will take place on SR 99 at the SR 145 undercrossing. The following detours will be in place next week, however, at no time will both directions of travel be subject to a detour at the same time.

- **Southbound traffic will be diverted off of SR 99 at the SR 145/Madera Avenue off-ramp and diverted back onto the southbound SR 99 on-ramp.**
- **Northbound traffic will be diverted off of SR 99 at the SR 145/ Madera Avenue off-ramp and diverted back onto the northbound SR 99 on-ramp.**

Motorists will experience delays in this area during this time and are encouraged to use an alternate route if possible.

As part of a partnership with the California Highway Patrol (CHP), CHP enforcement will be present during this time to provide extra support for traffic control. Portable changeable message signs (CMS) are in place along State Route 99 notifying motorists of the upcoming detours in this area.
