Subject: Call for Projects - FTA Section 5339  
Small Urban Formula Distribution

The California Department of Transportation's (Caltrans), Division of Rail and Mass Transportation (DRMT) is pleased to announce a call for Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5339 projects for the Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2014. Section 5339 is a formula program that provides funding for capital projects to replace, rehabilitate, and purchase buses and bus-related equipment, and bus-related facilities. This program was established under Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century (MAP-21), replacing the previous Section 5309 discretionary program established under the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, and Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU).

The funding available to small urban areas with populations between 50,000 and 200,000 for **FFY 2014** is **\$7,521,995.00**. Please refer to Exhibit 1 for the distribution for each region. DRMT will not be accepting applications to construct bus-facilities. Applications for Section 5339 funding is limited to projects to replace, rehabilitate, and purchase buses and bus-related equipment and facilities. Projects to construct Section 5339 bus-facilities may be included in future funding years.

All FFY 2014 projects must be programmed prior to the Division's grant submittal to FTA. **Please submit documents and application via e-mail to [5339apps@dot.ca.gov](mailto:5339apps@dot.ca.gov) on or before May 29, 2015.**

**All FFY 2014 projects must be submitted in PDF format via email and must include the following items:**

- **Completed Application**
- **Completed Program of Projects (POP) form**
- **All supporting documentation**
- **Current Authorizing Resolution**
- **FY 2015 Annual FTA Certifications and Assurances**
