HWY 330 MGS Guardrail project (EA 1E990)

The MGS Guardrail project on HWY 330 running through National Forest System lands has Forest Service concurrence. All standard operating procedures remain in effect. This project has been accepted and reviewed with stipulations. You are authorized to proceed with the activities proposed, subject to the following stipulations.

The following stipulations apply to this project

- Park vehicles in pre-disturbed areas.
- No side casting of any material onto the forest.
- Wash equipment prior to entering the Forest to help prevent the spread of invasive weeds
- The project site will be kept clean of debris. All food related trash items will be placed in closed containers and removed daily from the site.
- Obtain a fire permit for construction from Jack Masters (Patrol 36) at 909-234-7408.
- Equipment storage, hazardous materials, fueling, parking, and staging areas will be located at least 300' from drainages. In some cases, containment systems could be used where storage/use of chemicals was necessary within that distance.
- Notification to the Forest Heritage Program Manager (Bill Sapp, 909-382-2658) must take place immediately if any cultural materials are discovered.
- Informal consultation with U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service must be completed prior to construction activities.
