My name is Jose Alicea with District 10 Caltrans Maintenance Design,

I am writing, [per our conversation this morning](#), in regards to finding construction water sources for our upcoming 2015 Maintenance RHMA overlay project on Calaveras Route 4.

As part of our efforts to conserve water in the State, we have been directed to provide on our projects a non-potable water source in an information handout as part of our projects PS&E packages. .

This means that as the designer we need to check during design for a readily available non-potable water source 1st and if not possible, then a potable water source that the contractor can select to use during construction. I have included a copy of our Caltrans Directive and Water Usage Guidance.

Does Calaveras County Water Agency has both non-potable and potable water sources for this construction project above?

We understand, if a source is available, the awarded contractor would need to contact Calaveras County Water Agency at (209) 754-3543 or visit the main office at 120 Toma Court, San Andreas, Ca 95249 during working hours to set up their own account if they choose this means.

If you could please let me know if you do have a source or any additional information you can include, I would greatly appreciate it. Once I hear back from you I will include this information in my PS&E Package.
