Hi Chin,

As discussed in our phone conversation MID does have construction water available on a case by case basis. Typically, if we have water in our canals we make that available for construction uses.

In regards to your project on 152 and 59 we do have several canals in El Nido. If we have water in the canals during the time of the project (April 2016) it would be available assuming the pickup location is coordinated with MID. I have attached our application for construction water. As described in the permit we require a \$1,000 deposit and we charge \$200/acre foot (1 AF=326,000 gallons). MID does require a way to calculate the volume of water used (flow meter, counting water trucks filled, etc.). The estimated use of your project, 150,000 gallons, is about ½ an AF.

The project is still a year out so it is hard for us to tell if surface water will be in the canals at that time so MID cannot guarantee this availability. It is dependent upon when we start our irrigation season and the amount of surface water allocation (if any) we will have. As I mentioned earlier MID does not have any surface water available for 2015. The best thing to do would be contact MID next January to get more information on the availability.

TERMS FOR WATER USE

- 1 \$200.00 Permit Fee. The Permit Fee entitles the permittee to 1.00 acre foot of water or 326,000 gallons. Additional amounts shall be at a cost of \$200.00/Unit (1.00 AF).
- 2 Permittee must present proposal for MID approval as to the method the water will be removed from the canal/lateral.
No MID pump water shall be available for construction purposes, except under extreme circumstances and with the written permission of the MID Manager.
- 4 An annual \$1000.00 Deposit will be necessary at the issuance of the permit. After the completion of the work, The permittee will restore, to MID's satisfaction, the MID right of way to it's original condition. At that time, the \$800.00 will be refunded to the permittee. In the event damage is done to MID facilities or the right of way is not restored, the MID shall use any or all of the deposit for necessary repairs or restoration. The permittee shall also be responsible for any additional costs, in excess of the deposit, if additional work is required.
- 5 The MID assumes no responsibility with respect to the quality of water to be furnished pursuant to this Contract and does not warrant the quality of any such water.
- 6 Permittee agrees to indemnify the MID and will save the MID free, clear and harmless from any damage, damages, claims, demands, liability, costs and expenses, regardless of nature, that may be sustained, caused or suffered by the MID as a result of the use of the MID canal/lateral right of way and or the use of MID water.
