Hello Ms. Lisa Lea,

Thank you for your help. As per our phone conversation, my name is Jose Alicea with District 10 Caltrans Maintenance Design.

I am writing in regards to finding construction water sources for our upcoming 2015 Maintenance Overlay Project in San Joaquin and Stanislaus County, on Route 33, near Vernalis and Westley.

10-1E0004; Sta-33-PM 18.0/27.1, and SJ-33-PM 0.0/5.0

As part of our efforts to conserve water in the State, we have been directed to provide on our projects a non-potable water source in an information handout as part of our projects PS&E packages.

This means that as the designer we need to check during design for a readily available non-potable water source 1st and if not possible, then a potable water source that the contractor can select to use during construction. I have included a copy of our Caltrans Directive and Water Usage Guidance.

Does West Stanislaus Irrigation District have either non-potable and potable water available that could be listed as a potential water source for this construction project (10-1E0001) in this area?

We understand that if a source is available, the awarded contractor would need to contact W Stanislaus Irrigation District to apply for a temporary construction permit prior to the start of construction and pay whatever fee if they choose this source.

If you could please email me back or call me to let me know if you do have a source or any additional information on the process, I would greatly appreciate it. Once I hear back from you I will include this information in my PS&E Package.



