Dear Mr. Cruz

This letter will confirm that water is available for the SR-7 Pavement Rehabilitation Project work in Imperial County.

The procedure for obtaining construction water is as follows:

Obtain and fill out an Imperial Irrigation District Encroachment Permit and an Application For Temporary Water Use Permit. The Encroachment Permit must be mailed in with a check for Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00). The Encroachment Permit must be mailed in 3 weeks before the project begins. The Application for Temporary Water Use Permit can be mailed to the Holtville Division Office. The Temporary Water Use Permit will then be assigned an account number and billed Four Hundred Twenty Five Dollars (\$425.00) for activation. Additionally water used will be billed at \$85.00 Per Acre Foot. The Temporary Water Use Permit is available at:

If pumps are used and placed on a canal bank an "Application For Temporary Water Use" permit will be required for each individual pump. Pumps will also be required to have a meter so that the amount of water used can be recorded. The permit is valid for a maximum of one year. Once the permit is approved, IID will guarantee that sufficient water is available for the SR-7 construction project.
