B. Technical & Professional Skills & Abilities:

Must have the ability to perform quality assurance testing on a variety of materials; e.g., technical, physical and chemical tests on construction materials such as concrete, soils, water and metals. Must be able to perform calculations using percentages or ratios and plot data to evaluate test results. Must also be familiar with basic computer applications such as Lotus Notes, Microsoft, Excel, FileMaker Pro, Misrosoft Word and Caltrans custom-made applications. Some travel and field work may be required.
