




# Bicycle & Pedestrian Master Plan

## Project Summary:

The Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan (BPMP) facilitates the design and implementation of a bicycle and pedestrian network that will provide a safe, affordable and accessible transportation alternative to a low-income, minority community. The BPMP also promotes a more sustainable community by improving access to transit and business centers, while improving air quality and public health.

## Community Outreach

- The first workshop informed the community of the purpose and objective of the BPMP, identified bicycle/pedestrian needs and generated ideas for future projects.
- A second workshop gathered community input on bicycle/pedestrian network improvements.
- A survey was posted on the City's website for six months; copies of the survey were provided to participants during the first workshop, in both English and Spanish.

### Environmental Justice Community Outreach:

- Direct stakeholder interview were conducted in order to obtain input from specific stakeholder groups.

## Project Outcome

- A long-range plan to improve safety and the convenience of bicycling and walking in Guadalupe.
- Provide guidance for planning and development of bicycle/pedestrian infrastructure.
- Propose improvements to infrastructure and support facilities.
- Provide direction to develop multi-lingual education programs.

## Successes & Next Steps

- The BPMP was designed to meet guidelines for bicycle plans that seek final approval and funding from the State.
- The list of prioritized projects, estimated costs, and funding sources produced in this document facilitates the City's next step to apply for funding the proposed improvements.
- The City will explore volunteer and partnership programs to reduce the implementation costs of planned projects and programs.
