Requires every State agency to communicate and consult with California Indian tribes. Bill would authorize state-certified credit unions, with the approval of the appropriate tribal governments, to operate branches on reservation or rancheria lands of federally recognized tribes. SB 162	Anderson	Economic development: federally recognized Indian Tribes. Bill adds to the nonexclusive list of topics that state agencies may cooperate with federally recognized Indian tribes by consulting “on a government-to-government basis, in a respectful and meaningful manner,” with respect to a fee-to-trust land acquisition application, as specified. The bill would prohibit a state agency from opposing specified fee-to-trust land acquisition applications for purposes of “housing, environmental protection,	Passed Sen. 5/31/11; to Asm. Com. 		<p>or cultural preservation.” Defines a federally recognized Indian tribe as a tribe appearing on the list published by the Secretary of the Interior. As introduced, the bill required the Gaming Policy Advisory Committee to meet minimally twice a year and the Gambling Control Commission to consult with the committee on recommended proposed regulations.
