Subject: **VACATION RESOLUTION**

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The California Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission approve the vacation resolution summarized below.

## **ISSUE:**

It has been determined that the facilities in the vacation resolution summarized below is not essential to the proper functioning of the State Highway System and may be disposed of by vacation. Upon the recording of the approved vacation resolution in the county where the facility is located, the public's right of use of the facility will be abandoned. The vacation complies with Sections 892, 8313 and 8330.5 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described in the summary.

## **RESOLUTION:**

Resolution A898 – 10-Ama-49-PM R10.8  
(Request No. 16481) - 2 Segments

Vacates right of way in the county of Amador along Route 49 near it's junction with Main Street, consisting of superseded highway right of way no longer needed for State highway purposes. The County was given a 90-day notice of intent to vacate and did not protest such action.
