Re: FY 2006/07 to 2011/12 Federal Transportation Improvement Program; Amendment # 13

We have completed our review of the Southern California Association of Governments' (SCAG) 2006/07 to 2011/12 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP) Amendment # 13, as requested by your letter of June 2, 2008.

We find SCAG's FTIP Amendment #13 was developed based on a continuing, cooperative, and comprehensive transportation planning process in accordance with 23 USC 134 & 135, 49 USC 5303-5305, and 23 CFR 450. The California Department of Transportation assures this amendment has met the financial constraint requirements included in our transportation planning regulations, i.e. 23 CFR 450.324(e). Furthermore, the projects in this amendment have met the conformity requirements pursuant to 40 CFR 93.126 as noted in the conformity determination letter dated June 6, 2008. The 2008 SCAG Regional Transportation Plan and FTIP Amendment # 13 conformity determination were jointly issued by the Federal Highway Administration and the Federal Transit Administration.

This letter constitutes approval of Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP) Amendment # 13. The SCAG FTIP Amendment # 13 is approved and included into California's 2006/07-08/09 FSTIP, with the understanding the eligibility of individual projects is subject to the applicant's satisfaction of all FTA and FHWA administrative requirements.

This approval is based on the California Department of Transportation's assurance that the funding for this amendment does not adversely impact the FSTIP Financial Plan.
